STANDARD INSTALLATION

- Separate all mounting hardware as shown. 1.
- 2. Place a bead of plumbers putty or silicone under the drain rim #1.
- 3. Put drain #1 directly into the drain opening of the sink.
- From underneath the sink, slide the rubber gasket #2 up. Slide paper 4. gasket #3 into place where the drain and sink meet.
- Hand tighten the lock nut #4. DO NOT OVER TIGHTEN. 5.
- 6. Insert the sealing washer #5 into the recess of nut #6.
- Install tail pipe#7 into the bottom of seat #1 by tighening the #6 nut. 7.
- Be sure to trim away excess silicone or plumbers putty from the top of the 8. seat #1 after drain is installed.
- 9. Protect with spray wax protectant (W900-WAX).

CARE & CLEANING INSTRUCTIONS

- Do not use alkaline, acid based detergents, abrasive polishes, scouring cleansers, S.O.S. Pads or scotch brite pads when cleaning your decorative lavatory drains.
- Do not leave corrosive chemicals or solids laving in the bottom of the sink basin, such as coffee grounds, vinegar, etc.
- After normal use, always wipe the exposed surface area of your drain with a clean soft cloth. This will aid in limiting water spots.
- For normal cleaning, just wipe with a damp cloth and dry with a soft cloth.
- If a chemical cleaner is required when cleaning, windex or a mild dish . washing soap can be used.


