Maintaining the Finish:

Here are a few simple steps to keep your polished brass bath, bar & kitchen fixtures looking beautiful for years to come.

DAILY

When you finish using your sink, adopt the simple method of "RINSE and WIPE". When water dries, it often leaves behind unsightly calcium and hard water stains, which may alter the appearance in an undesirable way. In addition, when anything is left on the surface of the sink such as toothpaste or liquid soap, chemicals within the substance can alter the finish. Always remember to rinse with water and wipe with a soft cloth after use.

AS NEEDED

Use water and a clear mild non-citrus liquid dish soap with a non-scratch sponge to gently clean the entire surface. Rinse with water and wipe with a soft cloth.

If your brass sink has lost its luster, or the clear coat has noticeably worn through, you can easily reapply the clear coating. Please contact Premier Copper Products for additional details on how to purchase and apply the coating product.

To further enhance the beauty of the finish and add an extra layer of protection from substance related discoloration, use Premier Copper Wax Surface Protectant (Model Number: W900-WAX). Simply spray and wipe with a soft cloth.

AVOID

DO NOT USE **BRASS OR METAL POLISH CLEANERS** TO CLEAN OR POLISH THE SINK. DO NOT **POUR BOILING WATER** ONTO THE SURFACE OF THE SINK. ALL CLEANING PRODUCTS THAT CONTAIN **ABRASIVES, AMMONIA, BLEACH AND ESPECIALLY ISOPROPYL ALCOHOL, (COMMONLY KNOWN AS RUBBING ALCOHOL)**, WILL STRIP THE CLEAR COAT AND EXPOSE THE UNCOATED BRASS. ALL HARSH CHEMICALS WILL DAMAGE THE FINISH ON YOUR SINK!

IMPORTANT

Remember this is a solid brass sink with a clear coat finish that has been expertly applied. Any use of abrasives, chemical cleaners, or scour pads will result in removing the clear coating, therefore exposing the uncoated brass. Always remember to rinse with water and wipe with a soft cloth after use.

Additional Care Tips

- Always avoid using anything abrasive that may remove the finish
- Following this simple routine of 'rinse and wipe' after use, your polished brass sink will give you a lifetime of enjoyment!
- When working with acidic foods such as lemons, tomatoes, mustard, pineapple, citrus fruit, vinegar, etc., it is best to leave water running and remember to thoroughly rinse your sink immediately after use.

- For an added layer of protection, especially in 'hard water' areas, consider coating your sink with a high quality wax. We recommend "Premier Copper Wax Surface Protectant (Model Number: W900-WAX)". This will help maintain the luster while providing better water runoff.

Warranty Information

SINKS

Premier Copper Products warrants its sinks to be free from manufacturing defects in material and workmanship for as long as the original consumer purchaser owns their home.

The original dated sales receipt from an authorized dealer is required for any warranty claims. Damage due to installation error, product misuse and/or improper maintenance are excluded from this warranty.

Scratches, stains, hard water deposits, fading and discoloration that can occur under normal use are not covered under this warranty. Premier Copper Products does not warranty the finish on any polished brass products.

This warranty does not cover; shipping cost, labor cost, and/or damage incurred during installation, repair, or replacement, as well as any other kind of loss or damage. Warranty excludes all commercial and business usage.

DRAINS

Premier Copper Products warrants its drains and finishes, under normal use, to be free from defects in materials or workmanship, for a limited period of two years from date of purchase. Premier Copper Products will provide, at its sole discretion, replacement part(s) or product to replace those which have proven defective in materials or workmanship. If the product is no longer available, a comparable product will be provided. This Limited Warranty is nontransferable. Proof of purchase and the original receipt from the original consumer purchaser is required. Shipping charges may apply on any replacement parts.

Defects or damage caused by the use of other than genuine Premier Copper Products replacement parts will void this Limited Warranty. This warranty is extended to the original consumer only, and excludes product damage due to installation error,

product abuse, or product misuse, whether performed by a contractor, service company, or the consumer. Limited Warranty excludes damage due to normal wear and tear, harsh air or water conditions, or abrasive cleaners and/or materials. Warranty on finish does not cover improper maintenance.

Limited Warranty excludes all well water systems, commercial and business usage, whose purchasers are hereby, extended a one year Limited Warranty.

In no event shall the responsibility of Premier Copper Products exceed the purchase price of the drain. This Limited Warranty does not cover labor charges incurred and/or damages sustained in installation, repair or replacement, nor incidental or consequential damages. This warranty gives you specific legal rights, and you may also have other rights which vary from state/province to state/province.
